

Treasurer of the Committee, Monthly; to keep a fire in the building as directed by the Committee; to conform to all requirements of said Committee in all particulars in which his duty is not defined by the town, and to report to the Committee his doings, and the state of the Library, at any time they may require; and he shall be responsible for all books for which he cannot account to the satisfaction of the Committee, and for all damage done to them through his carelessness or neglect.

VI Any person belonging to the town twelve years of age and upwards may take books from the Library; provided, however, that no person shall have more than two books at any one time, and that all books taken by minors, shall be charged to their parents, guardians, or the persons with whom they reside. Teachers whether in public or private schools in the town shall be entitled to take books from the Library under this Article.

VII. All books belonging to the Library shall be returned thereto, on or before the last Wednesday of February of each year on penalty of a fine of five cents per volume, for each day during which the book is retained, thereafter; and no books shall be delivered after the Saturday preceding said Wednesday, until the Committee shall have prepared their annual report.

VIII. Any person retaining a book beyond the time specified on the label thereon, shall pay a fine of five cents for every Library day during which it shall be so retained; provided, however, that if a book shall be lost, and the person responsible therefor, shall notify the Librarian of the loss, the fine shall be remitted upon payment of the cost of replacing the book.
