- Art. 10. To determine for what purposes and on what conditions, the Town House shall be used the present year, and agree with some suitable person to take care of the same.
- Art. 11. To see if the Town will cause any books belonging to the town to be deposited in the Goodnow Library for safe keeping.
- Art. 12. To determine the manner of collecting taxes the present year.
- Art. 13. To choose a committee to distribute the interest arising upon the "Elisha Goodnow and other funds".
- Art. 14. To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of the grant made by the Town at a meeting March 22? to refund what has been paid by individuals to procure volunteers to fill the quota of the Town.
- Art. 15. To see if the town will instruct the Selectmen to print the receipts and expenditures ^{of} the Town the present year.
- Art. 16. To see if the town will take measures to erect a suitable building for a granary on their Poor Farm, to do or act on said subject as the Town may judge best.
- Art. 17. To see if the town will authorize their Overseers of the Poor to borrow money to pay bills as they become due to do or act as the Town may judge best.
