Art 2^d in place of Josiah Haines, James P. Willis and Dana W. Hayden, chosen at March meeting but not qualified.

Also chose Edwin Arnold to be a Surveyor of Lumber & Measure of Wood in place of Esnor Hunt, and Voted not to choose to fill said office made vacant by non-acceptance of James H. Cheney.

Also chose the following persons for a "Library Committee" for the "Goodnow Library" in accordance with the provisions of the first Article of the "By Laws for the Management of Said Library. Viz:

For the Centre District - Rev L. W. Shaw, for two years
 " North East do. - Charles Thompson Esq. for two years
 " South West do. - John B Goodnow, for three years
 " North West do. - Asahel Balcom Esq. for three years
 " South East do. - Benj H Richardson Esq. for one year
 " Assabetz do. - John H Harriman for one year

The Town voted to instruct the Library Committee to invest three hundred dollars of the interest arising upon the "John Goodnow Library Fund" annually, until the principal of said Fund shall amount to the sum of the original Bequest.
