Art 3 The following report was presented to the town.

"The committee appointed by the Town at a meeting held March 22^d 1864. to take all proper and legal measures to fill the quota of the Town under the call of the President of the United States for two hundred thousand men dated March, 14, 1864, report as follows"

The Town's quota under that call as reported by the Board of Enrolment for the 7th District was ten men. There have been seven men accredited to the town by volunteer enlistment, at an expense of nine hundred and ten dollars - the remaining three were drafted and accepted.

The committee recommend to the Town to assume of this debt the sum of eight hundred and seventy five dollars, which will be one hundred and twenty five dollars per man, and that they authorize the selectmen to borrow the money and pay the same."
