At a legal Town Meeting holden at Snelbury on Monday, Sept. 26, 1864, the Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows, viz.

Art 1 Chose Capt James. Moderator

Art 2 The Selectmen reported the laying out of a piece of Town way on petition of Joseph Smith and others and said report was accepted and ordered to be recorded.

Art 3 Voted to choose a Committee of three, by nomination, to investigate the matter referred to in this article and to report at the annual meeting in November next, and chose Capt Abel B. Jones, Thomas P. Merrill & Asahel Balcom

Art 4 Report of the Selectmen relative to recruiting men to fill the quota of the town under the last call of the President, read and accepted and the Selectmen authorized to borrow money to carry into effect the recommendations contained in said report.

Then Voted to dissolve this meeting
