In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in elections to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury, on Tuesday, the eighth day of November next, it being the Tuesday next after the first Monday of said month, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to bring in their votes to the Selectmen for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and Receiver General, Auditor of Accounts, and Attorney General for this Commonwealth, a Councillor for district No Six, and a Senator for district No. three, - their votes for Twelve Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, and a Representative in in the Congress of the United States for District No. Seven, a County Treasurer, and a County Commissioner for the County of Middlesex, and a Register of Deeds for the Middlesex South District, all on one ballot.

Also to bring in their votes for a Representative in the next General Court of Massachusetts for Middlesex District No. Sixteen, upon a separate ballot, both the foregoing ballots to be deposited at one checking.

Polls to be opened at ten o'clock A.M. and may be closed at one o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs,
