to assemble at the Town Hall in said town, on Tuesday the eighth day of November next, at one o'clock in the afternoon, to act on the following Articles, viz:

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting;
- Art 2 To see if the Town will accept of a piece of Town way as laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Joseph Smith and others,
- Art 3 To hear the report of the Committee, chosen September, 26th, 1864 to investigate the subject of the third article of the Warrant for the meeting of that date, and take such action upon said subject as the town shall deem best
- Art 4 To see if the Town will take measures to new lay or repair the sluice south of the Common.
- Art 5 To see if the Town will grant the free use of the Town Hall to the Soldier's Aid Society, and cause it to be opened, warmed, and lighted whenever they shall desire it.
- Art 6, To see if the town will instruct the Overseers of the Poor, to hire a Warden on the Poor Farm, previous to the first of March, if they shall judge it to be for the interest of the Town; to do or act as the town shall judge best.
- Art 7 To hear and act on Reports.
