To Samuel A Jones Constable
of the Town of Sudbury in Said County- Greeting-

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the town hall in said town on Monday the second day of January, next at one o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following Articles, Viz

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting

Art 2^d To see what action the town will take in regard to a call of the President of the United States dated Dec. 19th 1864 for three hundred thousand volunteers.

Art 3^d To hear the report of the committee chosen to investigate the claims of members of the "Wadsworth Rifle Ensembles" to pay from the town for their time while in the service of the United States, agreeably to a vote of the town passed April 29th 1861, and take any action on said subject which the town may deem best

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House at each of the public Meeting houses and at some public places in the Village of Assabet, two sabbaths at least before the time of said meeting.
