At a Legal Town Meeting hold at Sudbury on Monday the 5 day of January A.D. 1865 the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore Moderator

Art 2 Voted to raise the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars for each man that may be assigned to the town of Sudbury as a part of the quota of said town, under the call of the President of the United States. Dated Dec 19th 1864. provided the same can legally be done.

Voted also to instruct the select men to procure a sufficient number of men to fill said quota, if they think proper.

Art 3 Report of Committee referred to in this article accepted.

Art 3 Voted to instruct the Assessors of the town to assess upon the valuation of last year, a sum of money sufficient to cover the amount to which those persons designated in the report of the above named committee as "Citizens of Sudbury" - excepting the name of Mortimer Johnson - are entitled,
