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Art 9 To see if the Town will take any measures to prevent their School houses from being broken to pieces by scholars attending the several schools, or any other Persons

Art 10 To determine the manner of repairing highways, town ways and bridges the ensuing year, and grant money to carry the same into effect.

Art 11 To see if the Town will accept of a Town way, laid out by the Select men on petition of Amory Maynard and others.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the Public Meeting Houses, and at some public place in the Village of Assabet, two Sabbaths, at least, before the time of said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
