At a Legal Town Meeting holden at Shelbury on Monday the sixth day of March A.D. 1865. the Articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows. viz

- Selectmen " Thomas P. Whitbush, Charles Hunt and Walter Rogers. Selectmen
- Assessors " Asahel Balcom John H. Dakin and James Moore - Assessors
- Treasurer and Collector of Taxes " Samuel A. Jones Treasurer and Collector of Taxes
- { Voted to let out the business of Treasurer and Collector of Taxes, and the person taking the same shall perform all the duties of both said offices, for the year ensuing, as required by law or by vote of the town, for the sum for which it is bid off and shall give bonds to the satisfaction of the Selectmen; and then the said business was let out to Samuel A. Jones (he being the lowest bidder therefor) for the sum of seventy-two dollars)

- School Committee " Gardner H. Smith, (for the S.E. District) and John H. Harriman for Assabet District School Committee for three years;
