other necessary Town officers, not chosen as above.

Art 3^d Voted to let out the business of Librarian of the
"Goodnow Library" to the lowest bidder in the
same manner as last year, and said business
was taken by Isaac Clark for the sum of forty-
eight dollars. (Said Clark being the lowest bidder therefore)

Art 4 Voted to instruct the School Committee to appoint
a Superintendent of Schools, as provided for by
law, and that the compensation of said Super-
intendent, be two dollars for each day's and
one dollar for each half day's services.

Art 5 Voted that the School committee be instructed
to examine the furniture in the several school
houses in town, excepting that in Assabet District
to remove said furniture from the house in
which it is in the best condition, to replace
the old furniture so removed, by purchasing
new for said house, and to use the old
furniture so removed to repair or replace
the broken and mutilated furniture in
the other school houses

Art 6 Voted to allow the Law Reports and other similar
books to be removed to the office of Charles Thompson
he being responsible for the safe keeping of said books,
and allowing free access to them by the inhabitants of the town.
