"The Overseers of the Poor for the year ending March, 6, 1865, submit the following Report.

Whole number of paupers at the Poor house, March, 1st 1864, was fourteen, admitted during the year, four, — making a total of eighteen on the first of March 1865.

Furnished to strangers 156 meals, being equal to the board of one person seven weeks and three days, and lodgings 66 nights, — equal to nine weeks and three sevenths.
