

Art 7 A Report was made by the committee on the subject of the "War Tax" referred to in the action of the Town under Article 3^d of the Warrant for the town meeting of the 2^d day of January last, and the town voted that the collector of Taxes be instructed to report a list of names of all who have paid said tax, to the town at the annual Town meeting in April next. All further action on said subject was put over till said April meeting.

Art 8 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to provide a set of runners for the hearse before the next winter.

Art 9 Voted that the matter referred to in this Article be referred to the school committee, with instructions to report at April meeting.

Art 10 Voted to grant the sum of twelve hundred dollars for the repair of highways, townways and bridges the ensuing year, and that the price for labor on the same, be fixed at twenty cents per hour. Voted also that the highway tax of non-residents be made among Taxes, and collected with other Town Taxes.

Art 11 Voted not to accept the report of the Selectmen on the laying out of the road petitioned for by Amory Maynard & others, and to instruct the Selectmen, to ascertain, what arrangements, if any, can be made with said Amory Maynard concerning the making of said road, and to report to the Town at April Meeting.

Then voted to dissolve this meeting.
