

- Art 9 To see if the Town will accept of a town road as laid out by the select men on petition of Amory Maynard and others.
- Art 10 To hear and act on reports
- Art 11 To see if the Town will authorize their Overseers of the Poor to borrow money to pay bills as they become due.
- Art 12 To see if the town will discontinue the road known as the New Bridge Road, to do or act in reference to said road as the town shall judge best.
- Art 13 To see what the town will do regarding a request from the town of Acton for an allowance for for the tuition of scholars belonging to Sudbury who attend school in Acton
- Art 14 To see if the town will construct doors between the Town Hall and lobby, or make any other alterations in said Hall, to do or act as the town shall deem best
- Art 15 To see if the town will establish in each school districts as may desire it, branches of the Town Library, with a portion of the books belonging to said Library, and choose or agree with suitable persons to take charge of the same. to do or act in reference to said subject as the town shall judge best
- Art 16 To determine the manner of warning Town Meetings the ensuing year.
