and all Political Causes, - for the "Ladies Soldiers Aid Society", and for the Military Company about to be formed in Military District No. 145. Whenever they wish to use said hall for Officer Drills, and meetings for choice of Officers.

Voted, also, that said hall be opened warmed lighted and taken care of free, - once a month, for Meetings of the Society known as the Comprehensive Temperance Society, and inhabitants of the town for the purpose of Dancing.

Voted, also, that for all other purposes, for which the hall shall be used, when an admission fee is not taken, the person or persons using it shall pay the expense, only, of Lighting, warming and Taking care of it while it is used.

And for all other purposes, not provided for above the person or persons using the Town House shall pay for the use of the house in addition to the expense of lighting warming &c.

Then voted to let out the Taking care of the Town house to the lowest bidder on the same conditions, as in the year 1862, as recorded on Page 200 of this Book of Records, and that the sum of money for which it is bid off shall be payment in full for all services required by all votes that have been or may be passed by the town during the year ensuing.

Then let out the the above named business to W^m H. Bent for the sum of twenty nine dollars

Art 6 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money to pay bills that may be presented before the taxes are collected
