the Town of Sudbury, in said County, Greeting
In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachu-
setts you are required to notify and
warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury
qualified to vote, in Town affairs, to meet
at the Town House in said Town on
Monday, the 29th instant at 2 o'clock P. M.
Then and there to act on the following Articles

Viz:—

- Art 1 To Choose a moderator to preside in said Meeting,
Art 2 To see what action the Town will take in regard
to refunding money such has been contributed
by individuals, in aid of and for the purpose
of filling the quotas of the Town of Sudbury, or
furnishing men for the present war under any
requisition, order or call of the President of
or the War Department of the United States
during the year eighteen hundred and sixty four

And you are directed to serve this Warrant
by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town
House, at each of the public Meeting houses,
and at some public place in the Village of
Assabet, two Sabbaths, at least, before the time
of said Meeting

Hereof fail not and make due return of
this warrant with your doings thereon to the
Town Clerk at or before the time of meeting
as aforesaid.
