At a legal Town meeting holden at Sudbury on Monday May 29th 1865. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted on as follows. viz:

Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator

Art 2 Voted to refund all money contributed by individuals to fill Quotas of the town of Sudbury during the year 1864, as provided for by "Chapter 152 of the Acts of 1865."

Voted also that the Chairman of this meeting appoint a committee of five persons to examine and decide all claims against the town on account of money contributed by individuals for the above named purpose, and the following persons were appointed, viz Thomas P. Howland, Charles Knut, Walter Rogers, J. P. Fairbanks and Abel B. Jones. and said committee were instructed to examine claims and report at ~~at~~ an adjourned meeting to be holden on Monday June 12th.

Then voted to adjourn this meeting to Monday June 12th at 2 o'clock P.M.

According to adjournment the the meeting assembled at the Town Hall. — The report of the above named committee was read and after being amended was accepted by the Town as hereafter recorded
