The Town voted to raise the sum of six thousand eight hundred and forty-four dollars and fifty cents (\$6844.50) to pay all claims allowed in said report.

Voted also to instruct the Selectmen to borrow money to pay said claims, as soon as possible, on the best terms they can, and to settle said claims within ninety days by the payment of money, or by giving notes in behalf of the Town, said notes to bear interest at a rate not exceeding seven and three tenths per cent per annum and be payable at the office of the Town Treasurer.

Voted that the above named Committee be discharged from further service in the examination of claims.
