A.D. 1865, at the Town Hall in Sudbury, it ap-
peared by the records of meetings in said towns

of votes in said District for a Representative
to the next General Court of Massachusetts
was four hundred-thirteen (413) That Charles
R. Damon of Wayland had two hundred
thirty-three (233) - Charles H. Campbell of Wayland
