

November 1865

At a Legal Town Meeting holden at the Town hall in Sudbury on Tuesday the seventh day of November A.D. 1865. The Articles in the warrant for said meeting were taken up and acted upon as follows, viz:

Art 1st Chose Capt James Meowie Moderator

2 Voted to build two additional steps in front of the Town House, and to grade the ground in a suitable manner to correspond.

Voted that the chairman of the meeting appoint a committee of three persons to superintend said work, and the Moderator appointed Messrs Webster Moore, Thos P. Hensbut and J. S. Mount for said Committee.

Art 3 Voted to pass over this article

4th No action taken on this article

5 Voted to leave the matter referred to in this article, with the Selectmen, with instructions to settle the whole matter in such manner as shall, in their judgement, do justice to all interested.

6 Verbal report by the Selectmen relative to a claim of Webster Moore, for compensation on account of care of the Town House, - Voted to leave the whole matter to the Selectmen. Report of School Committee relative to new furniture for School Houses, read and accepted.

Report (verbal) of the Selectmen relative to an application of certain persons, for the use of the Armory for a music
