- Art 9 To make provision for the payment of bills for work on the Highways and other bills that may be presented.
- Art 10 To see what action the Town will take to provide for the payment of notes against the town which may be called for.
- Art 11 To determine the manner of collecting taxes the present year and agree with some suitable to collect the same.
- Art 12 To see if the Town will authorize any alteration to be made in the Town Hall, and choose a Committee for said purpose.
- Art 13 To see if the town will order the straightenings, as laid out by the County Commissioners, over Mine May Brook and Meetinghouse Hill, to be completed. To do or act as the town shall judge best.
- Art 14 To see if the Town will provide the Village of Assabet with a Lock-up.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House at each of the public Meeting-houses, and at some public place in the Village of Assabet in said Town, two Sabbaths at least before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon at or before the time of as aforesaid, to the Town Clerk.
