At a Legal Town Meeting holden at the Town Hall in Sudbury on Monday the fourth day of March A.D. 1867, the Articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows:

Art 1st Chose James Moore-Moderator.

Art 2^d Chose Jonas S. Hunt Town Clerk
Selectmen " Thomas P. Merrill - Walter Rogers and George Goodnow - Selectmen

Assessors " Asahel Balcorn - Dexter C. Jones and John W. Dakin - Assessors

Overseers of the Poor " Samuel A. Jones - John B. Goodnow and Alfred N. Thompson - Overseers of the Poor.

Voted that The Offices of Town Treasurer and Collector of Taxes be consolidated, that the duties of both be performed by one person, and that the same be let out by the Moderator, to the lowest bidder, and that the sum for which it is bid off shall be payment in full for the performance of all the duties of the two offices required by law or by vote of the town, and the same was let out to Samuel A. Jones for the sum of Fifty Dollars.

Treasurer & Collector Then the above named Samuel A. Jones, was Chosen Treasurer & Collector of Taxes by ballot.
