Report of the Selectmen on the subject of the Town Debt & interest Read & Accepted

Art 8

Voted to grant the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars for the repairs of Highways, Town ways and Bridges the present year to be apportioned and expended in the same manner as last year - that the price for labor be fixed at twenty cents per hour - and that the Highway Tax of Nonresidents be made a money Tax and collected with the other Town Taxes.

Voted that the Selectmen be authorized to use any unappropriated money now in the Treasury
