- Art 9 To pay bills that may be presented also to borrow money for the same purpose if it is necessary.
- Art 10 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money to pay notes against the Town, which may be called for.
- Art 11 Voted that the Taxes for the current year be made payable and collected as follows - viz:
 All single Poll Taxes - payable on demand.
 All other Taxes against the inhabitants of the Town shall be payable in two equal installments: the first on the first day of September - the second on the first day of December, and all Taxes assessed upon nonresidents (including Highway Taxes) be made payable in full on the first day of September.
 Collection of Taxes chosen under Article 2 of this Warrant
- Art 12 Voted to choose a committee of three persons to investigate the subject of alterations in the Town Hall, and report at April meeting: and chose J. P. Fairbank, J. S. Mount & S. A. Jones for said Committee.
- Art 13 Voted that the "straightening" referred to in this Article be completed and chose Messrs J. M. Jones Thomas P. Harlow & Webster Moore to be a committee to superintend the same.
- Art 14 Voted that the subject of this Article be referred to the Select men with instructions to investigate and report at April Meeting.
