To Samuel A Jones, Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in Said County. Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble, at their Town Hall, on Monday the first day of April next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following Articles Viz:

- Art. 1.- To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.
- Art. 2.- To fill any vacancies in Town Offices occasioned by non acceptance, or otherwise.
- Art. 3.- To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 4. To grant money for all necessary town purposes.
- Art. 5.- To see if the Town will accept a list of jurors presented by the Selectmen.
- Art. 6.- To determine for what purposes and on what conditions the Town Hall may be used the present year, and agree with some suitable person to take charge of the same.
- Art. 7.- To choose a committee to distribute the interest on the "Elisha Goodnow" and other funds.
- Art. 8.- To determine the manner of having Town Meetings the coming year.
- Art. 9.- To see if the Town will rescind all votes respecting the "Goodnow Library" passed at the last March Meeting, which are not in accordance with their present by-laws.
