Art. 10.

To see if the town will provide suitable buildings in different parts of the Town for the repository of books belonging to the Town "Good now Library"; and appoint Librarians for the same. To do or act as the town shall deem best.

Art. 11.

To see what action the Town will take in reference to a stone monument near Concord line.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting Houses and at some public place in the Village of Assabet in said Town two Sabbaths at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at or before the time of meeting aforesaid.
