Meeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of said town of Sudbury, qual-
ified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the
Town House in said Town on Monday the
30th inst at 2 o'clock P.M. then and there to
act on the following Articles Viz

- Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
- Art 2^d To choose a committee to let out the making of
the road as laid out by the County Commissioners
on Petition of Amory Heynard and others
- Art 3^d To see what instructions the town will give
their Collector of Taxes in regard to the
Tax assessed to Horace Heard
- Art 4 To see what action the town will take in
regard to rebuilding "Sherman's Bridge", so called.
- Art 5 To see what action the town will take in regard
to the making of Special Repairs on the Highways.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by post-
ing an attested copy thereof at the Town House at
each of the public Meeting Houses and at some
public place in the village of Assabet in said
town two Sabbaths at least, before the time
of said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return
of this Warrant with your doings thereon
to the Town Clerk, at or before the time of
meeting as aforesaid
