At a Legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury on the 30th day of September A.D. 1867. the Articles in the above warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz:

- Art 1 Chose Thomas P. Hurlbut. Moderator
- Art 2^d Voted to choose a committee of three to let out and superintend the making of the road referred to in this article, and chose Messrs Abel B. Jones, Asahel Bolcom and Reuben S. Willis for said committee.
- Art 3^d Voted to instruct the Collector of Taxes to proceed forthwith to collect the Taxes assessed against Horace Heard according to law, provided, that said collector and the Chairman of the Select Men are satisfied that said Taxes are collectible.
- Art 4 Voted that the Surveyor of Highways, for the ward in which Sherman's Bridge is located, be instructed to examine said bridge and make such repairs as he shall think necessary.
