To Samuel A Jones, Constable
of the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting.
In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury,
qualified to vote in Elections, to meet at
their Town Hall, in said Sudbury, on
Tuesday the fifth day of November next
it being the next Tuesday after the first
Monday of said month, at ten o'clock in
the forenoon, to bring in their votes to the
Selectmen, for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor,
Secretary, Treasurer & Receiver General, Auditor
of Accounts, and Attorney-General for this
Commonwealth; a Councillor for District
No. Six; a Senator for the Fifth Middlesex
Senatorial District; a County Commissioner,
and a County Treasurer for the County of
Middlesex, and a Register of Deeds for
the Southern Middlesex District - all upon
one ballot. Also to bring in their votes for
a Representative in the next General Court of
Massachusetts for Middlesex District No.
Nineteen, upon a separate ballot; both the
foregoing ballots to be deposited at once
checking.

Polls to be opened at half-past 10 o'clock
A.M. and may be closed at one o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury, qualified
to vote in Town affairs, to assemble at the Town
Hall, in said Town, on Tuesday the fifth
day of November next, at one o'clock, in the
afternoon to act on the following articles;
viz.

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting

Art 2^d To hear and act on reports
