Then voted to dissolve this meeting.

At a meeting of the Town Clerks of the
Towns of Sudbury, Acton and Wayland
said Towns composing the Nineteenth Middle
sex Representative District holden at the
Town Hall in Sudbury on Wednesday Nov 6th
1867 - it appeared by records of meetings in
said Towns on the day previous, that
Willard Wheeler of Sudbury was elected
to represent the said District in the
General Court of Massachusetts for the year
one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight
