To Samuel A Jones, Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County, Greeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at their Town House, in said Sudbury on Monday, the 2^d day of March next at 10 o'clock A.M. then and there to act on the following articles Viz

- Art. 1 To choose some person to act as Moderator of said Meeting.
- Art. 2^d To choose all necessary town officers for the ensuing year
- Art. 3^d To choose a member of the Goodnow Library Committee
- Art. 4th To determine the manner of repairing Highways, Town-ways and bridges the coming year
- Art. 5th To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 6th To make provision for the payment of notes against the town, which may be called for.
- Art. 7 To determine the manner of collecting taxes the coming year, and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
- Art. 8 To see if the Town will lease their poor farm - to do or act in reference to said Farm as the Town shall deem best
- Art. 9 To see if the town will rescind the vote passed at the April meeting, last, in reference to the free use of their Hall and take any vote in regard to said Hall which the town may desire
- Art. 10 To see if the town will repair one or more of their School Houses the present year, and put new furniture into the same.
