

Art. 7. Voted that the offices of Town Treasurer and Collector of Taxes, be consolidated. that the duties of both offices be performed by one person and that the same be let out to the lowest bidder. - that the sum for which it is bid off shall be payment in full for the performance of all the duties of both offices, which are required by law or by vote of the town. And the same was let to Samuel A. Jones for the sum of ninety dollars.

Art. 9. Voted that the vote in reference to the use of the Town Hall, passed at April Meeting last, be so far rescinded as that that parties using the Hall for dancing, shall be required to pay the expense of lighting, warming and taking care of the same. until

Art 10 Voted that the chair appoint a committee of three persons to examine the several school houses in town, and report their condition, what repairs are necessary, and some plan for repairing the same. at April Meeting. and the chair appointed Messrs J. P. Fairbank Edward E Brown & Horner Rogers for said committee

Art 4th Again Taken up, and the town Voted to authorize the Selectmen to instruct the Surveyors of Highways for the past year, to keep the roads in order until April Meeting, and that each of said Surveyors, as have expended all the highway tax of the past year, shall be paid by the town for labor as required by this vote
