April Meeting 1868

Middlesex S.S.

To John Goodnow, Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall, in said town, on Monday the sixth day of April next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following Articles, Viz:

- Art. 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art. 2 To choose all necessary Town officers not Chosen at "March Meeting", and fill vacancies occasioned by non-acceptance or resignation; also to choose a member of the "Goodnow Library Committee."
- Art. 3 To see if the town will rescind the vote passed at "March Meeting" whereby it was decided not to choose Assessors for the present year.
- Art. 4 To hear and act on reports
- Art. 5 To grant money for all necessary Town purposes, the present year and appropriate the same.
- Art. 6 To make provision for the payment of notes and accounts against the town which may be called for the present year.
- Art. 7 To see if the Town will accept of a list of jurors presented by the Select-men
- Art. 8 To determine for what purposes, and upon what conditions, the Town Hall shall be used the present year and choose or agree with some suitable person to take charge of the same
