

The foregoing report was submitted by Messrs

Abel B. Jones. B. H. Richardson Committee
and the same was accepted and adopted
by vote of the town

The committee chosen at March Meeting to examine
the several school houses in town, report their con-
dition, and some plan for repairing the same.
Have attended to that duty and submit the fol-
lowing report.

The committee recommend in the Landham
District that the Town procure one eighth of an
acre of land of Gardner Smith, on the north side
of the road, near where the school house now stands,
grade the spot, and move the school house upon it.
To substitute sheathing for plastering through the
entire house, - to erect a separate building for
fuel and privies. - put in new outside doors, repair
blinds, paint the outside and paint and grain the
inside of the house, remove the old furniture and
replace it with new, and enclose the lot with
a board fence with stone posts; - the whole of said
alterations and repairs to be done the present year.

The south west school house to be temporarily repair-
ed the present year, and the next year to be shingled,
sheathed, painted and newly furnished the same
as the Landham school house.

The North East school house to be repaired in
the same manner the year following, and the house
in the Centre District to be painted and new fur-
nished in the upper room.

The old furniture taken out of the first houses
repaired to be used to replace damaged furniture
in the others
