To John Goodnow, a Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury on Monday the first day of March next at ten o'clock in the fore noon. then and there to act on the following Articles.

Art 1st

To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting

Art 2^d

To choose all necessary Town officers for the ensuing year, also to choose a member of the Goodnow Library Committee for the term of three years.

Art 3

To determine the manner of repairing Highways Townways and Bridges the coming year, and grant money for the same

Art 4

To hear and act on reports

Art 5

To determine the manner of collecting Taxes the coming year, and choose or agree with some suitable person to collect the same.

Art 6

To see if the town will discount any Taxes that may be offered for that purpose

Art 7

To see if the town will cause the Hears House to be removed or enlarged, to do or act in any relative to said House as the town shall think best

Art 8

To see if the Town will take any action relative to the use and care of the Town Hall, to do or act &c

Art 9

To hear and act upon any report which may be offered by the committee chosen in November last, to investigate the subject of school Houses and Districts, or act in any way upon the subject of schools, school districts or school buildings as the Town may think best.
