

present year, That the price for labor be fixed at Twenty cents per hour, that the money be apportioned and expended out in the year 1867. and that the Taxes of Non residents be made payable in money and collected with the other Town Taxes

Art 4 Voted that the reading of and action upon reports be postponed till "April Meeting"

Art 5 Voted that the Taxes be made payable and collected in the same manner as last year
Voted also to let out the doing of the business of Collector of Taxes and Town Treasurer, To the lowest bidder, and the same was let out to Samuel A. Jones for the sum of Fifty-nine Dollars. said sum to be payment in full for the performance of all the duties of both said offices whether required by law or by vote of the town

Art 6 Voted to discount the Tax of Jesse Richardson of Concord, ^{for the year 1867} to the amount of three $\frac{54}{100}$ Dollars
Voted also to discount the Tax of Mrs Sally Goodnow, for the year 1867 - amounting to the sum of Fifteen $\frac{26}{100}$ Dollars.
Voted also to discount the Tax of Jonas Tower for the year 1868. amounting to the sum of eleven $\frac{94}{100}$ Dollars

Art 7 Voted that the chair appoint a committee of three persons. to examine the Hearsse House and report at "April Meeting" what should be done concerning it, and the Chair appointed Messrs J. Parker Fairbank, Abel B. Jones, & J. S. Hunt, for said Committee.

Art 8 Voted that a Committee of three be chosen by nomination, to consider the whole subject of the use and care of the Town House, and report some plan for opening said House,
