To James L. Willis, a Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said county Greeting,

In the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify
and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sud-
bury, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet
at the Town Hall in said Town, on Monday
the fifth day of April next at ten o'clock in
the forenoon, then and there to act on the follow-
ing Articles: namely,

- Article 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.
- Art 3^d To grant and appropriate money for all necessary
Town purposes.
- Art 2. To choose all necessary town officers not chosen at
March Meeting, and fill vacancies occasioned by
non acceptance or resignation
- Art. 4. To hear and act on Reports
- Art 5. To make provision for the payments of notes
and accounts the present year
- Art 6. To see if the Town will accept of a list of
jurors presented by the Selectmen.
- Art 7. To choose committees to distribute the
interest of the Town Funds
- Art 8. To see if the Town will order special repairs
to be made upon any of the highways and
grant Money for the same: Also to take measures
to furnish material for repairs of highways wherever
it may be necessary.
- Art 9 To act upon the ninth article of the warrant
for 'March Meeting'
