

- Art 10 To see if the town will order the School Committee to appoint a Superintendent of Public Schools the present year and fix the salary of said officer if appointed
- Art 11 To hear the report of the Town House Committee, and act in any way relative to the use and care of said house.
- Art 12 To hear and act upon the report of the Hearse House Committee
- Art 13 To see if the Town will build a receiving Tomb the present year, and provide any articles necessary for the use of the inhabitants in cases of deaths or funerals
- Art 14 To see if the Town will compensate Lucius P. Bent. for injuries occasioned by an alleged defect in the highway near the house of John Ryand.
- Art 15 To see if the Town will dispose of any of the wood now standing upon the Poor Farm
- Art 16 To see if the Town will give any instructions to the Assessors the present year.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the town House at each of the public meeting houses and at the Post Office in the village of Assabet. in said town, two Sabbath at least before the time of said meeting.
