

7th The Hall, nor any part of the building shall be allowed to be kept open in any case after Two O'clock A. M.

8th No loud talking, singing or any unnecessary noise shall be allowed in any part of the building that shall tend to disturb or annoy any parties using or occupying the Hall

9th No person shall be allowed to remain in the entries or lobbies when the House is occupied unless by consent of those having control of the House

10th Any person who shall deface the house by writing, marking, scratching or cutting any part of the same, or in any way defacing or mutilating the furniture shall be dealt with according to Law

11th The Selectmen shall agree with some suitable person to take care of the Town House for the Term of one year from the fifth day of April 1869

12th The person taking care of said house shall open the same when so ordered by the Selectmen - light and warm the same when necessary - keep the same clean and in good order. wash the floors when ordered by the Selectmen close and fasten the Blinds and doors when the house is not occupied - saw the wood and put the same in the wood closets, - remove the snow from the road to the house, so as to make it safe and convenient passing to and from the same - and be present at all times when the house is occupied.

He shall also keep a record of each time the house is opened, - for what purposes and by whom used, and the amount of money received from each - during the year
