Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in Elections, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town, on Tuesday the second day of November next, it being "the Tuesday next after the first Monday" of said Month, to bring in to the Selectmen their votes for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and receiver General, Auditor, and Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a Councillor for District Number Six, a senator for Middlesex Senatorial District Number five a County Commissioner for the County of Middlesex, and a Representative in the Congress of the United States, to fill an existing vacancy for the Seventh Congressional District all upon one ballot.

Also to bring in their votes, for a Representative to the next General Court of Massachusetts for Middlesex Representative District Number Nineteen upon a separate Ballot—both the foregoing ballots to be deposited at one checking.

Polls to be opened at One o'clock P.M. and may be closed at three o'clock P.M.

And you are required to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting houses, and at the Post Office in the Village of Assabet in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting
