To James & Willis a Constable of the Town of Sudbury in Said County, Greeting:
In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet in the Town Hall, in said town, on Monday, the seventh day of March next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon then and there to act on the following Articles:

Viz:

Art. 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.

Art 2^d To choose all necessary town officers for the ensuing year. Also to choose one member of the "Goodnow Library Committee" for the term of three years

Art 3^d To determine the manner of repairing highways town ways and bridges, the coming year, and grant money for the same

Art. 4. To hear and act on reports.

Art. 5. To determine the manner of collecting taxes the present year and choose or agree with some person to collect the same

Art 6 To see if the Town will build another school house in the N.E. School District the present year, ^{repair} or change the ^{location of the} old house in said district, create an additional school district in that section of the town, or make any change in any of their school districts or school houses

Art 7 To see if the Town will order the receipts and expenditures of the town for the past year to be printed
