

Art 8 To see if the town will petition to the Legislature, in aid of the Petition of E. P. Carpenter and others for a Charter for a rail road from Frammingham to Lowell

Art 9 To see if the town will accept of the laying out of a lot of land by the Selectmen for a gravel pit, near Landham School House, as petitioned for by Nahum Goodnow & others

Art 10 To see if the town will compensate Richard Dwyer for the loss of his horse, on account of an alleged defect in the highway

Art 11 To see if the town will take any action concerning a suit commenced by the Commonwealth against the town on account of the support of Thomas Pierce

Art 12 To see if the town will adopt the provision, of Chapter 366 of the Acts of the General Court of this Commonwealth for the year 1869 concerning Field drivers

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting^{an} attested copy thereof at the Town House at each of the public Meeting Houses, and at the Post Office in the Village of Assabet, in said Town two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.
