

- Art 7 Voted to instruct the Selectmen for the past year to print the receipts and expenditures of said year
- Art 8 Voted, unanimously, to petition to the Legislature of the Commonwealth, in aid of the Petition of E. P. Carpenter and others, for a charter for a Rail Road from Framingham to Lowell, and chose, by ballot, Messrs Charles Thompson, Jones S. Hunt and John W. Dakin a Committee to petition in behalf of the town according to the above vote, and to use all proper means for the furtherance of the enterprise.
- Art 9 Voted to reject the report named in this Article
- Art 10 Voted to pass over this Article.
- Art 11 Voted to instruct the Overseers of the Poor to defend the suit referred to in this Article
- Art 12 Voted that the Town adopt the provisions of Chapter 366 of the Acts of the General Court of this Commonwealth for the year 1868, concerning Field Drivers
