Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

To James L. Millis, a Constable of the town
of Andover in said County: Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts you are required to notify and
warn the inhabitants of the Town of Andover
qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at
the Town Hall in said Town on Monday the
fourth day of April next at ten o'clock in
the forenoon then and there to act on the fol-
lowing Articles, namely.

- Art. 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
- Art. 2^d To choose all necessary town officers not chosen
at the March meeting, and fill vacancies oc-
casioned by non-acceptance or resignation.
- Art. 3^d To grant and appropriate money for all necessar-
y purposes.
- Art. 4th To hear and act on reports.
- Art. 5th To make provision for the payment of
notes and accounts the present year.
- Art. 6th To see if the Town will accept a list of jurors
presented by the Selectmen
- Art. 7th To choose committees to distribute the
interest of the Town Funds
- Art. 8th To act upon the third Article of the Warrant
for March meeting last
- Art. 9th To see if the Town will authorize the Overseers
of the Poor to heat the house on the Town farm
by putting in a Furnace, to do or act as
the Town shall think best.
