Art. 4. Report of School Committee - accepted
 Report of Committee on Rules for the Receiving Art
 Tomb - read accepted and ordered to be re-
 corded as follows, Viz:

"The Receiving Tomb shall be placed in the
 care of the Sexton of the Town, who shall keep
 the same in proper condition at all times
 subject to examination and approval of the
 Selectmen

The use of the Tomb shall be free to all
 the inhabitants of the town under the fol-
 lowing restrictions Viz:

1st All bodies deposited in the Tomb
 after the ground shall be frozen or covered
 with snow so much as to prevent conven-
 iently digging; and before the first day of
 April, shall be removed as soon as the
 state of the ground will admit, and shall
 in no case be allowed to remain after the
 first day of May.

2^d All bodies deposited after the first day
 of April and before the ground shall
 be frozen or covered with snow, shall
 not be allowed to remain in the Tomb
 more than three days, unless in the
 judgment of the sexton a sufficient rea-
 son exists for a longer time. Which may in
 his discretion be extended to not more than
 one week in any case,

3^d If the friends of any deceased person whose
 body shall have been temporarily placed in
 the Tomb, shall refuse or neglect to cause
 the same to be removed as provided for in
 the above rules, it shall be the duty of
