

- Art 5 Voted to instruct the Treasurer to borrow money, if necessary, to pay notes and accounts that may be presented for payment the present year
- Art 6 Voted to accept the following list of jurors, as presented by the Selectmen viz

Art 7 Voted that the Overseers of the Poor be a committee to distribute the interest of the funds left for the benefit of the Poor; and the school committee to distribute the interest of the Elisha Goodnow Fund left for the purpose of supplying poor children with books.

Art 8 Voted to grant the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to be expended in labor and materials for repairing highways townways and bridges the present year; that the said sum be apportioned in the several wards in the usual manner; that the price for labor be fixed at Twenty cents per hour, and that the Surveyors be instructed to cause all the above money to be worked out or expended before the first day of November next.

Voted also to grant an additional sum of four hundred dollars, to be distributed in the several wards ^{by the Assessors} according to their best judgement of the necessities of the roads, and expended under the direction of the Surveyors after the highway taxes are expended.

Art 9 Passed over
