

Apr 10 Voted to unite the two highway wards known as the "Assabet" and Powder Mills" wards, and choose one surveyor instead of two.

Apr 11 Voted to discount a part of the Real Estate Tax of Jesse Richardson of Concord amounting to the sum of Three 700 Dollars
Also the Tax of Jonas Lower, of Ten 93 / 100 Dollars
Also the Tax of Lott Hayden, of Seven 23 / 100 Dollars.

Apr 12 Voted to remove the school house in the N.E. District from its present location, and Messrs Aaron Hunt, Elisha Moore and Andrew Hunt were appointed a committee to superintend said removal.

Said Committee were instructed to procure a suitable spot of land between the barn of Alfred N. Thompson and land of Aaron Hunt on which to place said house, and to cause said house to be thoroughly repaired and refurnished after its removal.

And said committee were further instructed to examine the said house and if in their judgement it shall appear to be for the interest of the town to build a new school house instead of removing the old one they shall have power by this vote, to do so.

Apr 13. Voted to instruct the Assessors to print the Valuation and Assessments of taxes the present year, provided the general valuation of the town shall be taken

Apr 14 Voted to accept the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars from Charles Henry Paine Plympton Daniel Kimball, and Daniel Kimball Jr Executors and Trustees under the will of Henry Plympton late of Boston, deceased upon the trusts and conditions set forth
