Art 5 Voted to discharge the committee chosen on the fourth day of April last to build a school house in the southerly part of the N.E. District and chose Messrs Charles Thompson Luther G. Horn and Alexander Keynes, for a new committee and Alexander Keynes, having declined serving, the

remaining two members of the committee were authorized, to fill the vacancy - Then Voted to dissolve this meeting
