Art 2^d Voted, That the Town Treasurer be authorized and instructed to subscribe for, take and hold Capital Stock in the "Frammingham and Lowell Railroad Company" to the amount of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) according to the provisions of chapter 241 of the acts of the Legislature, for 1870, passed May 9th 1870.

Provided said Railroad shall not be located in any place more than half a mile from the last survey in the town of Sudbury.

The above vote was acted upon and determined by the use of the check list and ballots and decided by a vote of Forty four yeas and ten nays
